## SELECTED NURSING RESOURCES

### 1. Databases

#### CINAHL Plus With Full Text

Indexes journals related to nursing and allied health. Provides full text for more than 560 journals indexed in CINAHL. Of those, nearly 400 have cover-to-cover indexing in CINAHL. Contains more than 600,000 full text articles dating back to 1937.

#### Academic Search Premier

Indexes articles in magazines, journals, and newspapers, as well as some books and primary source documents, spanning virtually every area of academic study. Provides full text for more than 4,600 scholarly publications, including more than 3,500 peer-reviewed journals.



#### BioMed Central

An independent publishing house committed to providing immediate free access to peer-reviewed biomedical research



#### Proquest Psychology Journals

Indexes over 400 top psychology and related publications. Most articles are full text.

#### PsycINFO

Indexes journal articles, books and chapters, dissertations, and technical reports in the area of psychology



#### PubMed/MEDLINE

A service of the National Library of Medicine. Includes over 14 million citations for biomedical articles back to the 1950's from MEDLINE and additional life science journals. Includes links to many sites providing full text articles and other related resources.



#### Sage Nursing & Health Sciences Collection

Provides access to the full text of 24 peer-reviewed journals covering the following subject areas: Social studies of health, public policy, health services and administration, health education, community/public health nursing

#### ScienceDirect

Covers primarily scientific, technical and medical peer-reviewed journals as well as useful holdings in psychology and social sciences. Contains over two million articles and 40 million abstracts from all fields of science.



#### Scopus

Offers the broad coverage of scientific, technical, medical and social science literature. Includes academic, peer-reviewed and trade journals, as well as patents and scientifically oriented websites.



## Oxford Reference Online

Published by Oxford University Press. A fully-indexed, cross-searchable database of about 100 dictionary, language reference, and subject reference works. Includes such titles as "Dictionary of Nursing", "Concise Medical Dictionary", "Oxford Companion to the Body", and "A-Z of Medicinal Drugs".

### CLICnet

- Indexes books, videos, DVDs, and audios held at the libraries in the CLIC consortium (Members: Augsburg College, Bethel University, Bethel Seminary, College of St. Catherine, Concordia University, Hamline University, Macalester College, Northwestern College, University of St. Thomas)
- Includes eBooks (electronic books), available from NetLibrary, that can be read online anytime, anywhere



### MnLINK

- Provides access to the catalogs of most libraries in Minnesota
- Provides the citation information needed to place interlibrary loan requests



### WorldCat

- Provides access to the catalogs of numerous libraries worldwide
- Provides the citation information needed to place interlibrary loan requests

## **5. Research & Writing Aids**

### **Research Wizard**

Identifies resources with which to begin your research. Specify a subject for your research question, along with your time frame and the types of materials you need. The Wizard will bring back all kinds of good sources, from databases to quick reference to websites chosen by librarians as useful and credible for your subject.
